The minutes of the January 10, 2013 meeting were approved with a motion by Commissioner Greene and seconded by Commissioner Walraven.

Item I: Item one was a presentation by Cory Myers of Envisage Technologies of the Acadis Readiness Suite, Enterprise Training and Certification Management System. Mr. Myers presented to the Commission and interested parties an overview of the system and the applications that would streamline record keeping for law enforcement in the State of Arkansas. He explained the possibilities and capabilities of the system for law enforcement records.

Item II: Item two was in regard to a request from the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office for decertification of former Deputy Jonathan Parrish. A motion was made by Commissioner Morris to go forward with decertification and seconded by Commissioner Holladay. The motion was approved unanimously.

Item III: Item three was a request from the Pope County Sheriff's Office for decertification of former Jailor Ruby K. Kersten. Commissioner Wilburn made a motion to go forward with decertification. A second was made by Commissioner Jiles and approved unanimously.

Item IV: Item four from the Hot Spring County Sheriff's office was for decertification of former Deputy Robert D. Baucom. Commissioner Walraven moved to go forward with decertification. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Morris.

Item V: Item five was from the West Memphis Police Department requesting decertification of former Officer Tyrone Daniels. Commissioner Jiles made a motion to go forward with decertification and was seconded by Commissioner Holladay.

The Education Committee gave their recommendation for acceptance of the proposed new Standard for Training and Employment of Arkansas Law Enforcement. With a motion by Commissioner Cook and a second by Commissioner Walraven, to adopt the new standard was passed by a majority, with one vote not to accept the new standard.

During the Director's Report, Director Jones gave a report on the legislative proceeding relating to law enforcement and upcoming meetings. It was discussed that the April meeting would be held in Pocahontas at the Black River Law Enforcement Training Academy. Final arrangements would be announced at a later date. A suggestion to hold the July meeting during the Sheriff's Convention which will be held in Ft. Smith was also presented. This matter is to be confirmed at a later date. Meeting adjourned at 12:08 P. M.
